

## 27<sup>th</sup> Lions European Music Competition Thomas Kuti

In order to encourage talented young musicians all over Europe, a Music prize is presented annually on occasion of each Lions Europa Forum. In 2018 the instrument is the Flute, chosen by the host country, the Lions from Macedonia.

Participants must have their 24<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2018 or later.

Each member country of the Europa Forum may nominate one participant for the competition. Preliminary competitions are held in most of the participating member countries or in smaller regional areas.

The prizes in Skopje will be:

1<sup>st</sup> prize: 5'000 EUR; 2<sup>nd</sup> prize: 3'000 EUR; 3<sup>rd</sup> prize: 2'000 EUR.

And for the first time, as a special prize: Prize of the audience: 1.000 €.

(All listeners who are present at the Concert of the Six Best can vote!)

You are welcome to make a donation which will support the music competition in Tallin in 2019. Just get in touch with the chairman.

Please do not enter the Concert room during the performances.

In the combined 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> round all participants play the obligatory piece followed by the first of their individually selected pieces. The Jury then selects the best six performers for the final round based on the two performed pieces.

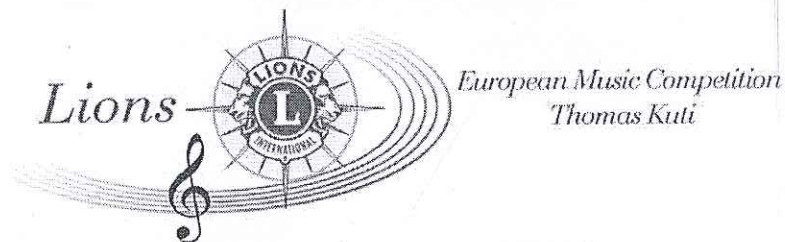
These six best will play their second individually selected piece in the final 3<sup>rd</sup> round.

The winner of the first prize has the honour of playing a new composition of Prof. Zivoin Glisic, a remarkable composer from Macedonia, in a world premiere at the Closing Ceremony. The noble sponsor is Lion Katja Segmüller from Germany.
