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ANALYSIS OF THE INTERACTIONS BETWEEN REAL COMPENSATION GROWTH AND LABOR PRODUCTIVITY GROWTH IN SELECTED COUNTRIES

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The link between labor productivity and labor compensation has been the subject of extensive debate and analysis among economists around the world. The data show that for the period 1948 - 1973 the value of the two variables is doubled. However, since the mid-1970s this relationship has become weaker. It can be concluded that the phenomenon of “great decoupling” between real compensation growth and labor productivity growth is increasing. The purpose of this paper is to examine whether and to what extent labor productivity growth is transmitted (through labor compensation) to workers. In this paper by applying econometric regression analysis an attempt has been made to examine the causal and correlative relationship between labor productivity and workers' compensation in selected countries (Hungary, Slovenia, Romania, Bulgaria, Croatia, and Macedonia). Thus, we use data on two variables for the period 1997 – 2018: real labor productivity and real labor compensation.
