The ensemble ConTempora promotes the music of our time through concerts, tours and recordings. Although founded only in 2014 by the Composers' Association of Macedonia, this professional ensemble consisting of twenty professional musicians has already performed and recorded a significant number of new pieces. The ensemble has performed at the ECSA General Assembly in Skopje, the festival Days of Macedonian Music, as well as other concerts in Amsterdam, Utrecht and Skopje. Actively engaged in the creation of new works, the ensemble has premiered compositions by Andovska, Ilievski, Petrovic, Tambuwun, Hemati, Pandevska, Dimusevski and others. Their first CD with music by Macedonian composers will be released by SOKOM this year.
