

















Liljana Jovanovic, Biljana Staffansson

Twin sisters BILJANA STAFFANSSON and LJILJANA JOVANOVIĆ, are coloratura sopranos. The public remembers them as musical child prodigies, who gave their first performance on television at the age of nine with a duet from "The Magic Flute "by Mozart. They completed their studies at the Faculty of Music in Belgrade and at the Luigi Cherubini Musical Academy in Firenze. Often performing together on stages in Europe, they sing in many languages. Their repertoire, both operas and concerts, includes Bellini, Chopin, Donizetti, Mozart and Verdi, as well as many Nordic and other composers. Their performances are noted for their brilliant interpretations and musicality and a superb upper register. Biljana Staffansson and Ljiljana Jovanović have sung on the operatic and concert stages in Europe including Belgrade and Warsaw, Brussels, Firenze, Rome, Stockholm and many more. They have performed in the presence of King Carl XVI Gustaf of Sweden and Queen Silvia.

ELENA ATANASOVSKA – IVANOVSKA graduated her music studies at the Faculty of Music in Skopje in the class of Prof. Boris Romanov with highest grade "cum laude". In 2003 she was rewarded with best student award by the foundation "Frank Manning". She accomplished her post-graduating studies in the class of Prof. Boris Romanov. She has won many international and national awards.

She had many performances with Macedonian Philharmonic Orchestra and on solo recitals. Remarkable are to mention her performances at recitals and concerts as piano accompaniment in USA, Italy, Spain, Portugal, Russia, Greece, Serbia, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Kosovo. Collaborated in many projects of FAM.E.S — Macedonian Radio Symphonic Orchestra in recording sessions of movies music. She is actively involved in the concerts of Macedonia Philharmonic Orchestra and continuously collaborating with many renowned artists.

In May 2015 she was invited by the music school "M. Balakirjev" from Moscow to participate as member of the jury of the international competition for Slavic music in Moscow, Russia. The pianist Atanasovska is regularly participating at music events in the country within "Ohrid Summer Festival", "Skopje summer festival", "Days of Macedonian music", "Esenski muzicki svecenosti", "Bitfest", "Gevgelija autumn" and abroad "Festival de Musica do Palacio da Bolsa" – Portugal, "Festiva de Musica de Sant Pere de Rodes" – Spain, "Carniarmonie" – Italy, "Saraevska Zima" – Bosnia and Herzegovina, "Guarnerius, Centar lepih umetnosti Jovana Kolundzije" - Serbia etc.

She works as associate professor for piano accompanying at the Faculty of Music. She is currently working on her PhD thesis.
